HOW TO USE LMX4®

- Use mild soap and water to clean the area before use (if required):
- » baby wipes are fine to use
- » do NOT use alcohol or acetone based cleansers including hand sanitiser, as they will strip the skin of natural oil.
- 2 Apply small amount of cream and gently massage into skin for 20–30 seconds:
 - » ensure liposomal base integrates with corneocyte layer and hydrolipid film.
- 3 Apply cream 2–3mm thick to completely cover the desired area:
 - » make sure there is no skin visible under the cream
 - » use tongue depressor or waxing paddle to ensure correct application of thickness – think "cake icing".
- 4 No occlusion is required, however if occlusion is desired, cover cream with cling wrap undisturbed for 30 mins.
- 5 If unoccluded, leave for 30 mins for the anesthetic to take effect:
 - » cream may dry, so apply a little more and mix in
 - » many procedures are adequately covered after 30 mins unoccluded
 - » LMX 30 mins without occlusion = 60 min FMI A with occlusion.⁷

6 Remove cream by wiping with a clean gauze or tissue. Additional skin preparation or cleaning may now be performed prior to intended procedure.

Note: Do not apply to large surface of body except on advice of a healthcare practitioner. Do not apply near eyes. Not to be used on broken skin.

I MX4[®] DOSING

- Use 1–1.5g per 10 square cm (10cm²) of skin.
- 25g per average full face may be required for most painful procedures (eg: deep fractional laser). 10g total for full face is ample for superficial procedures – 1g per 30 square cm (30cm²) of skin.
- LMX4 max surface area in adults = 600 square cm (600cm²).
- After a 60g LMX4 application to 400 square cm (400cm²) skin for 3 hours – lidocaine blood levels 0.05–0.16 ug/ml (toxic levels > 5ug/ml).⁸

DOSING EXAMPLE for dermal rolling / needling:

- Full face:
- » 0.5–1.0mm use 5g–10g
- » 1.0–1.5mm up to 10g
- \gg > 2.0mm use up to 10g-15g
- For neck: use 5g tube
- For chest: use 10g tube




